

PRIVACY POLICY

I – INFORMATION RELATING TO THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THE SITE

1. This section contains information on how Liveviewphoto.com management with reference to the processing of Liveviewphoto.com users' data.
2. This information is also valid for the purposes of art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, Code regarding the protection of personal data, and for the purposes of art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, for subjects who interact with Liveviewphoto.com and can be reached at the address corresponding to the home page: Liveviewphoto.com
3. The information is valid only for Liveviewphoto.com and not for other websites that may be consulted by the user through links contained therein.
4. The purpose of this document is to provide information about the methods, times and nature of the information that the data controllers must provide to users when connecting to the web pages of Liveviewphoto.com, regardless of the purposes of the connection itself, according to Italian and European legislation.
5. The information may be subject to changes due to the introduction of new regulations in this regard, therefore, the user is invited to check this page periodically.
6. If the user is under sixteen years of age, pursuant to art. 8, paragraph 1 of EU Regulation 2016/679, must legitimize his/her consent through the authorization of his/her parents or guardians.

II- DATA PROCESSING

1. Data Controller

1. The controller shall be the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data. He also deals with security profiles.

2. Data Processor

III – COOKIES

1. Type of cookies

1. The Liveviewphoto.com site uses cookies to make the user's browsing experience easier and more intuitive: cookies are small strings of text used to store some information that may concern the user, his preferences or the internet access device (computer, tablet or mobile phone) and are mainly used to adapt the operation of the site to the user's expectations, offering a more personalized browsing experience and remembering the choices you have previously made.
 2. A cookie is a small set of data transferred to your browser from a web server and can only be read by the server that made the transfer. It is not executable code and does not transmit viruses.
 3. Cookies do not record any personal information and any identifiable data will not be stored. If you wish, you can prevent some or all cookies from being stored. However, in this case the use of the site and the services offered may be compromised. To proceed without changing the options relating to cookies, simply continue browsing.
- Below are the types of cookies that the site uses:

2. Technical cookies

1. There are a number of technologies used to store information on your computer, which is then collected by other sites. Among these, the best known and most used is HTML. They are used for navigation and to facilitate access and use of the site by the user. They are necessary for the transmission of communications on the electronic network or to the supplier to provide the service requested by the customer.
2. The settings to manage or disable COOKIES may vary depending on the internet browser used. In any case, the user can manage or request the general deactivation or deletion of cookies by changing the settings of their internet browser. Such deactivation may slow down or prevent access to certain parts of the site.
3. The use of technical cookies allows the safe and efficient use of the site.
4. The COOKIES that are inserted in the browser and retransmitted through Google Analytics or through the blogger statistics service or similar are technical only if used for the purpose of optimizing the site directly by the owner of the site itself, who may collect information in aggregate form on the number of users and how they visit the site. Under these conditions, the same rules apply, in terms of information and consent, to Analytics COOKIES, as to technical cookies.
5. From the point of view of duration, a distinction can be made between temporary session cookies that are automatically deleted at the end of the browsing session and are used to identify the user and therefore avoid logging in to each page visited, and permanent cookies that remain active on the PC until they expire or are deleted by the user.
6. Session cookies may be installed in order to allow access and permanence in the reserved area of the portal as an authenticated user.
7. They are not stored persistently but exclusively for the duration of browsing until the browser is closed and disappear when the browser is closed. Their use is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers consisting of random numbers generated by the server necessary to allow safe and efficient exploration of the site.

3. Third-party cookies

1. In relation to the origin, a distinction is made between cookies sent to the browser directly from the site you are visiting and third-party cookies sent to your computer data from other sites and not from the one you are visiting.
2. Persistent cookies are often third-party cookies.
3. Most third-party cookies are tracking cookies used to identify online behavior, understand interests and thus personalize advertising proposals for users.
4. Third-party analytical cookies may be installed. They are sent from the domains of these third parties external to the site.
5. Third-party analytical cookies are used to detect information on user behavior on Liveviewphoto.com. The survey is anonymous, in order to monitor performance and improve the usability of the site. Third-party profiling cookies are used to create profiles relating to users on Liveviewphoto.com, in order to propose advertising messages in line with the choices expressed by the users themselves.

6. The use of these cookies is governed by the rules prepared by the third parties themselves. Therefore, users are invited to read the privacy policies and instructions for managing or disabling cookies published on the relevant web pages.

4. Profiling cookies

1. Profiling cookies are those that create profiles to the user and are used in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user in the context of web browsing.
2. When using these types of COOKIES, the user must give explicit consent.
3. Article 22 of EU Regulation 2016/679 and Article 122 of the Data Protection Code will apply.

IV- DATA PROCESSED

1. Data processing methods

1. Like all websites, this site also uses log files in which information collected automatically during user visits is stored. The information collected may be as follows: Internet protocol (IP) address;

- Type of browser and parameters of the device used to connect to the site;
- Name of the internet service provider (ISP);
- Date and time of visit;
- The visitor's referring and exiting web page;
- If necessary, the number of clicks.

2. The aforementioned information is tested rate in automated form and collected in aggregate form only in order to verify the correct functioning of the site and for security reasons. Such information will be tested rate based on the legitimate interests of the owner.

3. For security purposes (anti-spam filters, firewalls, virus detection) the automatically recorded data may also include personal data such as the IP address, which could be used, in accordance with the laws in force on the subject, in order to block attempts to damage the site itself or to cause damage to other users or harmful or criminal activities. These data are never used for the identification or profiling of the user, but only for the purpose of protecting the site and its users, such information will be used according to the legitimate interests of the owner.

4. If the site allows the insertion of comments, or in the case of specific services requested by the user, including the possibility of sending the Curriculum Vitae for a possible employment relationship, the site automatically detects and records some user identification data, including the email address. These data are intended to be voluntarily provided by the user at the time of the request to provide the service. By posting a comment or other information, the user expressly accepts the privacy policy and, in particular, agrees that the content posted is also freely disseminated to third parties. The data received will be used exclusively for the provision of the requested service and only for the time necessary for the provision of the service.

5. The information that users of the site will decide to make public through the services and tools made available to them, is provided by the user knowingly and voluntarily, exempting this site from any responsibility for any violations of the law. It is up to the user to verify that they have the permissions to enter personal data of third parties or content protected by national and international regulations.

2. Purpose of data processing

1. The data collected by the site during its operation are used exclusively for the purposes indicated above and stored for the time strictly necessary to carry out the specified activities and, in any case, no longer than 2 years.

2. The data used for security purposes (blocking attempts to damage the site) are kept for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purpose indicated above.

3. Data provided by the user

1. As indicated above, the optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site involves the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.

2. Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the site prepared for particular services on request.

4. Support in configuring your browser

V- USER RIGHTS

1. Art. 13 par. 2 of EU Regulation 2016/679 lists the user's rights.
2. This website therefore Liveviewphoto.com intended to inform the user of the existence:
 - the right of the data subject to ask the data controller for access to personal data (art. 15 EU Regulation), their updating (art. 7, par. 3, letter a of Legislative Decree 196/2003), rectification (art. 16 EU Regulation), integration (art. 7, para. 3 lett. a Legislative Decree 196/2003), limitation of processing concerning him/her (art. 18 EU Regulation) or to object, for legitimate reasons, to their processing (art. 21 EU Regulation), in addition to the right to data portability (art. 20 EU Regulation);
 - the right to request the erasure (art. 17 of the EU Regulation), the transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including those whose retention is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed (art. 7 par. 3, letter b of Legislative Decree 196/2003);
 - the right to obtain certification that the operations of updating, rectification, integration of data, cancellation, blocking of data, transformation, have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case in which this fulfilment proves impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right (art. 7 para. 3, letter c of Legislative Decree 196/2003).
3. Requests can be addressed to the data controller at the aforementioned email address (without formalities) or using the form provided by the Data Protection Authority.
4. If the processing is based on art. 6 paragraph 1 letter a – express consent to use – or on art. 9 paragraph 2 letter a – express consent to the use of genetic, biometric, health-related data, revealing religious, philosophical or trade union beliefs, revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions – the user has the right to withdraw consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.
5. Likewise, in the event of a violation of the law, the user has the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority, as the authority responsible for controlling the processing in the Italian State.
6. For a more in-depth examination of the rights to which you are entitled, see art. 15 et seq. of EU Regulation 2016/679 and art. 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003.

VI – OBLIGATIONS

The Data Controller shall notify the Garante of the processing of personal data it intends to proceed, only if the processing concerns:

1. genetic, biometric or data indicating the geographical location of persons or objects by means of an electronic communications network;
2. data suitable for revealing the state of health and sex life, processed for the purposes of assisted reproduction, provision of health services by telematic means relating to databases or the supply of goods, epidemiological investigations, detection of mental, infectious and diffusive diseases, HIV positivity, organ and tissue transplantation and monitoring of health expenditure;
3. data suitable for revealing sexual life or the psychic sphere, processed by non-profit associations, bodies and organizations, even if not recognized, of a political, philosophical, religious or trade union nature;
4. data processed with the aid of electronic tools aimed at defining the profile or personality of the data subject or analysing consumer habits and choices or monitoring the use of electronic communication services with the exclusion of processing that is technically indispensable to provide the same services to users;
5. sensitive data recorded in databases for the purpose of personnel selection on behalf of third parties as well as sensitive data used for opinion polls, market research and other sample research;
6. data recorded in special databases managed with electronic tools and relating to the risk on economic solvency, the financial situation, the correct fulfilment of obligations, illegal or fraudulent conduct.

VI – SECURITY OF THE DATA PROVIDED

1. This site processes user data in a lawful and correct manner, adopting the appropriate security measures aimed at preventing unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or unauthorized destruction of data. The processing is carried out using IT and/or telematic tools, with organizational methods and logics strictly related to the purposes indicated.
2. In addition to the Data Controller, in some cases, categories of persons in charge involved in the organization of the site (administrative, marketing, commercial, legal, system administrators) or external parties such as (such as third-party technical service providers, postal couriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communication agencies) may have access to the data.
